	<p>Suggestions from committee members:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To do hands-on US MSK on a regular basis (i.e. once a month) in training centres with US machines and trainers.</li> </ul> <p>Dr Shereen and Dr Shuhailah informed that matter should be discussed with head of Rheumatology, Dr Molly and the trainers will need to get credentialing etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A meeting with Dr Molly will be held during March MSR-TUI Intermediate US course.</li> <li>- suggested time: 10 am throughout tea-break</li> </ul>	
5	<p>The logbook is already distributed to trainees who are in the US programme.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dr Hazlyna suggested to introduce and informed MSR members about the logbook during the next MSR combined.</li> <li>- Agreed by committee members and Dr Ong YC suggested Dr Ong PS.</li> </ul> <p>Dr Hazlyna enquired about rheumatologists who participated in numerous US MSK courses during their subspecialty training, but had completed subspecialty training before this programme is available.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- They are at least at intermediate level and are teaching US to trainees.</li> <li>- One of the reason they are facing difficulty in completing the logbook is because they are now working independently, thus unable to get supervisors signatures. They are also bogged down with clinical and administrative work.</li> </ul> <p>Logbook is important as it will be used in applying for credentialing.</p> <p>Suggestions to overcome this issue:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To do a mock exam</li> <li>- To do online course</li> </ul>	<p>Dr Ong YC to inform Dr Ong PS.</p> <p>All members to think of other ways to credentialed them.</p>
