- 2. routinely performing MSUS for the past 5 years, and
- 3. actively involved in teaching MSUS in Rheumatology (at least basic or intermediate level) for the past 2 years

OR

4. has achieved external recognition on MSUS in Rheumatology eg EULAR Level 1 or Level 2, RhMSUS or their equivalents
